Today's worship service will utilize the **Service for the Lord's Day**, beginning on page 1 of "Glory to God" (G2G), our brand-new hymnal. This will introduce us to the worship resources in the beginning of the book.

- The **hymns** will be announced, but they are (in order):
 - Gathering hymn: 390 - "Praise, Praise, Praise the Lord!"
 - First hymn: 1 - "Holy, Holy, Holy"
 - Hymn following sermon: 172 - "Blest Are They"
 - Final hymn: 610 - "O for a Thousand Tongues to Sing"
- Today's worship **responses** will be response "A" in each case.
- The **prelude** is "Come, Let Us Eat," which appears as 528 in Glory to God.
- The **anthem** is "Borning Cry," which appears as 488 in Glory to God.
- Our **scripture lessons** are 1 Corinthians 1:18-31, Psalm 15 (419 in Glory to God), and Matthew 5:1-12.
- The **sermon title** is "Blessings in Brokenness."
- The **offertory** is "I've Got Shoes," a traditional spiritual.
- The **affirmation of faith** is the Nicene Creed, found on page 34.
- During **communion** (pages 8-12), we will speak the responses
- The **postlude** is "I Am the Bread of Life," which appears as 522 in Glory to God.

We thank you for your strong support in acquiring Glory to God. We will dedicate it during worship next week, February 9. Our Worship, Music, and the Arts Committee will continue to introduce the new hymnal throughout the month of February.
